Year 11 GCSE Geography – Fieldwork Opportunity 2 Tuesday 25 September 2018

This fieldtrip is the second of two fieldwork opportunities that are part of the GCSE Geography course. In Geography lessons before the trip students will be preparing for the fieldwork and after the trip Geography lessons will focus on interpreting the data that was collected on the trip. This will then form part of the Fieldwork Exam that students will sit at the end of their GCSE course.

The fieldwork will be investigating how an ecosystem is managed and will cover the skill of measuring a flow and investigating how risk is mitigated at the coast.

The timings for the day will be as follows:

- 9.15am - Depart from Beccles Free School on the coach
- 10.30am - Arrive at Happisburgh, Norfolk
- Complete fieldwork at 3 sites between Happisburgh and Sea Palling
- 3.15pm - Depart Sea Palling, Norfolk
- 4.30pm - Arrive back at Beccles Free School

Students will need a **pencil** and a **waterproof coat** in case of bad weather. Students should wear appropriate clothes for a day of being outdoors; school uniform does not have to be worn. Students are allowed to bring cameras if they wish. All students will be provided with a packed lunch from school which will be paid for in the normal way, Free School Meals allocations will still apply.

Consent for this trip will be collected using ParentMail. We are asking for a contribution of £9.00, this price represents the minimum payment that will make the visit possible. Please ensure that payments are made through ParentMail by **Tuesday 18 September 2018**.
